NB: No family discount is applied to Kindergarten fees regardless of number of family members, but the Kindergarten child is taken into consideration when applying family discount to older children.

BUS:

Proximity to school (as crow flies)

Greater than 10 kilometres	\$1782.00 per student per year – inc GST

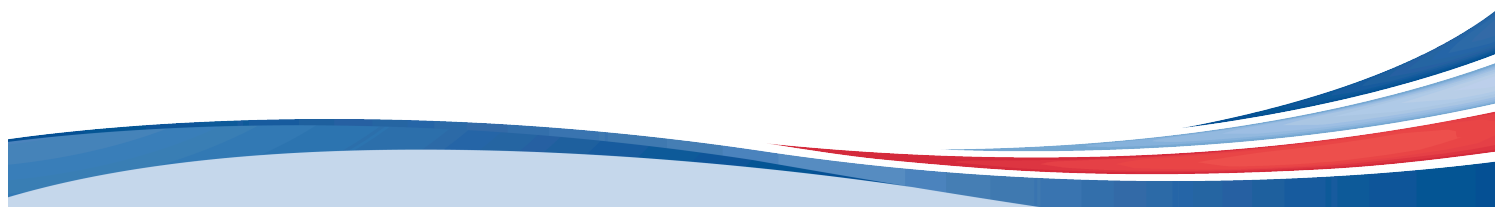
Note: Families will only pay for a maximum of three (3) bus fares. Extra students travel free.

PAYMENT OPTIONS:

Payment may be made using:

Bpay, Cash, Cheque, Credit card, Centrepay (Centrelink direct debit), or by privately arranged direct debit.

(Centrepay forms are available from your nearest Centrelink office, or the school office.)



Maintenance Fee

A maintenance fee will be charged at a rate of \$120 per family/year. (Twice/year) Families may wish to select the option of participating in Working Bees at least twice yearly. Involvement in Working Bee activities will result in the Maintenance fee being removed from your tuition account.

Swimming Lesson Fee

This is charged in Term 1 account only for students in Pre Primary to Year 6. \$125 per student.

Resource Fee

The resource fee covers: ITC Levy, Maths textbooks, student diary, Lexile subscription, Homework folder, Student Insurance etc. Not all students use all items each year.

Excursions

There will be class and school excursions from time to time. Excursions are compulsory as they are carefully selected to enhance the learning program of the college. A charge of \$25 per student/per term will be added to tuition fees to cover the cost of excursions. If the full amount is not expended on excursions throughout the year, the excess will be credited back to your account towards the end of Term 4.

Student 24hr/365 day Accident Insurance

The school annually takes out a student accident insurance policy for all students. This policy covers injury twenty-four hours a day, regardless of whether the accident occurs at school or not. The charge for this insurance is approximately \$15 per student/annum and will be included in the first tuition account each year. Claim forms are available at the school.

Low income families

Families in financial difficulty may apply for assistance with fees through the School Principal. The amount of bursary available is limited and there is no guarantee that all requests will be met. Families who already have children enrolled in the school will be given preference.

Applications must first be made through the Principal, who will then review this with a sub committee of the Management Committee. A full statement of income must be provided as part of the application. Applications are made and reviewed each six months.
