COLLEGE BUS SERVICE FEE

Carmel College offers bus transport for the primary and secondary. Please note to be able to use the bus system you must complete and return a bus application form annually. Cost is adjusted for less than 5 days.

Up to 10 Kilometres (Annual 5 days)	\$1,738.00 - Per Student
Greater than 10 Kilometres (Annual 5 days)	\$1,963.50 - Per Student

NB: Families only pay for the Maximum of three (3) bus fares. Subsequent students travel free.

All students who apply for boarding will be accepted at the discretion of the Principal.

All students accepted into boarding will follow the rules and regulations as outlined in the boarding handbook.

NB: Boarding Fees do not include any in school sporting options that are chosen per term or any out of school hours activity that your child/ren participate in.

PAYMENTS AND ACCOUNTS

OPTION A	Payment in Full - 5% discount
OPTION B	Payment in FOUR Quarterly instalments - 2.5% discount
OPTION C	Payment in 10 Monthly instalments
OPTION D	Payment in 20 Fortnightly instalments

School accounts are charged annually at the commencement of the school year.

The above options will apply and discounts will be honoured if paid by the due date/s.

A Fee Payment Commitment Form and Fee Payment option sheet is sent at the beginning of the year with your annual statement. The Payment Commitment Form must be completed by every family, and returned annually.

The College reserves the right to **DE-REGISTER** any student when payments, or satisfactory arrangements for such, have not been made by the due date shown on the Fee Payment Commitment Form.

If fees are not up to date, your child may be ineligible to attend optional camps, as decided by the Principal.

Should the College require the services of debt collectors, you, as the person financially responsible, will be liable for all costs associated in the collection process. The College will not be responsible for these costs.

S.I.D.E - School of Isolated and Distance Education - The above fee is the amount payable by the family after the school subsidy.

Core Courses - When there are not enough students to make a class viable, the College will cover the full cost.

Relevant Courses - When the course relates to the students study/career goal, the College will cover 50% of the cost and the remaining 50% will be added to your school fees.

Elective Courses - When the course is for personal interest, the College will not cover any of the cost and 100% of the cost will be added to your fees.

Whether the course is Core, Relevant or Elective is determined by the appropriate Heads of Department, the Director of Studies, and the Principal.

CERTIFICATE COURSES - TAFE Courses & Online - The above fee is the amount paid by the family associated with studying a certificate course.

Relevant Courses - When the course relates to the students study/career goal, the College will cover 50% of the cost and the remaining 50% will be added to your school fees.

Elective Courses - When the course is for personal interest, the College will not cover any of the cost and 100% of the cost will be added to your fees.

WORK LINK - Structured work place learning - Students who are enrolled for this program are interviewed the previous year before starting year 11. If the student changes their mind an interview fee of \$25 will be charged.

WITHDRAWAL OF A STUDENT

The Principal and College Registrar must be given a full term's notice in writing, prior to the withdrawal of a student. In default of such written notice, a full term's tuition fee will be charged in lieu of notice.

STUDENT ABSENCE

Families who take their children on extended holidays during the school term, or if a students attendance is below 90% without a medical certificate, may incur additional fees if the child's absence precludes the school from receiving State or Commonwealth per capita grants.
