# GENERAL

#### **Post Lockdown School Guidelines**

**For this week**, the protocols we are to adhere to at school are:

- · wear a mask at all times;
- practice 1.5 metres between adults physical distancing, where practicable; and
- follow good hand and respiratory hygiene practices.

#### Front Office and Classroom Access

If parents are wanting to enter the front office or classrooms, you will need to sign in as part of the school's visitor register AND use the SafeWA app or sign the Mandatory contact register.

If you wish to avoid this process, please feel free to get the attention of our office staff through the window and we will meet you outside the office.

#### **Medical Plans**

If your child suffers from any medical condition that may require management at school, please ensure that your child's treatment plan, information and medication is up to date. This includes asthma, allergies resulting in anaphylaxis (EPI Pens), diabetes or any other condition requiring management at school.

Please remember to check the used by date on your child's medication.

#### **Sickness**

If your child has a fever, cough or cold symptoms, we recommend that they see a medical professional to ensure that they are well enough to return to school.

Please remember to inform us when your child is absent from school and the reason for absence (eg sick, family reasons, doctor, dental or specialist appointment), so that this can be noted on our attendance records.

This can be done by phoning the front office, emailing primary.admin@cac.wa.edu.au or using the SKOOLBAG app on the morning of your child's absence.

If you were unable to attend registration day the envelope would have been sent home with your child on the first day of school. If you have not yet returned your forms, we encourage you to do so by THIS Friday, 12th February.

Each class has a set day once a week when they will participate in sporting games and have the opportunity to borrow books from the library.

#### **School Fees for 2021**

If you have not yet returned your 2021 Fee Commitment Form (the blue one attached to the back of your letter and fee statement) please return it **by THIS Friday, 12th February**.

If you have misplaced your form or would like to arrange a payment arrangement outside the advised options please feel free to contact the front office. It is important to note that the Prompt Payment Discount is only made available when payments are made on or before the following dates:

Option A: One annual payment with a 5% discount on tuition fees (due 26 February)

**Option B:** 4 quarterly payments with a 2.5% discount on tuition fees:

#### **CENTRELINK PAYMENT OPTIONS**

Centrepay - the easy way to pay your bills and expenses. Centrepay is a voluntary bill-paying service, which is free for Centrelink customers. Use Centrepay to arrange regular deductions to your school fees from your Centrelink payment. You can start or change a deduction at any time. The quickest way to do it is through your Centrelink account online. This can also be set up here at school, so no more time wasted in Centrelink queue's.

#### **IMPORTANT - DIRECT DEPOSIT PAYMENTS**

If you are paying your fees via Direct Deposit, please make sure you place CAP/family code (eg. CAP/DUNCD) as your description/reference to ensure the payment is assigned correctly, especially if you have children enrolled at both the secondary and the primary campus. Thank-you.

Fee Statements will be sent home monthly with the oldest sibling in the family. Please take the time to look through them to check all payments made by yourself are listed. If at any time

you are experiencing financial difficulty and unable to meet your scheduled payment, I encourage you either contact either Mrs Janine Taylor or myself on 9291 6399 or alternatively email narelle.duncan@cac.wa.edu.au.



#### Fire Season

It's summer, so here is a reminder of our fire safety procedures.



Any day classed as being a CATASTROPHIC FIRE DAY in the Perth Hills will result in school being cancelled for the day.

All schools in the Hills are on a special alert system and will be notified if such a day is forecast. This alert is normally done by 1pm of the day preceding and allows us time to notify parents.

ABC radio (720AM) announces all fire warnings and regularly keeps up to date. Therefore on extreme weather days, the school office will have the radio playing in the background to simply stay in touch with any current fire warnings.

If ever the school needs to be evacuated off site for events such as a bushfire, our destination is Advent Park Campground, Kalamunda Road, MAIDA VALE. Advent Park has a kitchen, toilets, shade, water and shelter available. This is also the location of off campus evacuation for the High School Campus.

If you at any stage hear of schools in this area being evacuated, please do not rush to school to collect students as you may create traffic issues that would prolong evacuation.


