9 Minutes...

As parents, each of us tries our very best. There are no perfect parents and no perfect kids (thank goodness!). Since we all are pulled in what feels like a million different directions each day, we all search for ways to build our parenting toolkits. While time can be short, it's a common goal to make our daily interactions with our children that much more meaningful.

Several years ago, neuroscientist Dr. Jaak Panksepp debuted his theory on how our children's routines can be broken up into nine important minutes each day.

According to Dr. Panksepp, the nine most important minutes of our children's days are:

- the three minutes after they wake up
- the three minutes after they get home from school
- the three minutes before they go to bed

No matter how young or old, children who develop strong early relationships with parents, family, or teachers really learn how to get along with others, cooperate, and pay attention in school. Therefore, everyone benefits from time spent talking with each other, even if it's compact as those nine important minutes.

An Asthma Action Plan includes information for the school if your child requires asthma medications prior to sport or at any other time during school hours.

If your child has their own medication, we recommend that their teacher or front office staff look after this for them.

Please also ensure that your child also has their own spacer. A spacer is a holding chamber shaped like a football or tube. It makes it easier to take asthma or COPD medication.

Kindy Enrolments

Congratulations to Mrs Jessica Foster, Mr Foster and Isabella on the safe arrival of Natalia Isabel. She is just adorable!





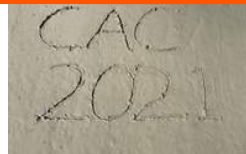
Interschool Basketball Competition

In 2020, the annual Cup Cake and Market Day raised enough money to support the following charities chosen by the Year 5 class:

- Perth Children's Hospital:** We provided \$1000 to the PLaE team. They help to provide entertainment and leisure activities for children in the hospital.
- Year 10 - Carmel Adventist College Mission:** \$1000 was donated to help with 'She Rescue'. This is a safe place in Cambodia that helps young girls finish school and learn skills for employment.
- RSPCA - Animal Rescue:** \$1000 was provided to support rescued animals. The donation helped to provide vital medical treatment, the safety of shelter, and behaviour training for animals to recover from their ordeal.
- Perth Homeless Support Group:** \$800 was provided to support the Perth homeless community. The funds helped provide rescue food hampers and clothing items such as new underwear and socks to people in crisis or at risk.

This year, the 2021 Year 5 class have voted to support the following charities:

- **Perth Children's Hospital** - Kids with Cancer - Providing items for leisure/entertainment and accommodation for family members of sick children
- **Perth Homeless** - Providing food and clothing to the Perth homeless
- **RSPCA** - Supporting rescued and mistreated animals
- **Year 10** - Mission Service Initiative (Carmel Adventist College - Secondary)
- **Malala Fund** - Malala Fund's Education Champion Network helps girls' secondary education around the world
- **Christian Blind Mission Australia** - an independent Christian development organisation, dedicated to preventing and curing blindness
