NOTICE OF ROADWORKS

PLEASE NOTE THAT AS OF FRIDAY (JULY 21) THE INTERSECTION OF LAWNBROOK RD AND FIRST AVE WILL BE CLOSED. The City of Kalamunda is currently upgrading the Lawnbrook Road East and First Avenue intersection. The work includes widening of the intersection and installation of a pedestrian median island on Lawnbrook Road East. The construction requires a change in road levels and therefore cannot be open to traffic until the works are complete. They will endeavour to keep the closure to a minimum but unfortunately, there will be disruption to the school traffic over the next 3 weeks. Please follow detour signs as provided. We thank you for noting this and being patient as the roads are improved.
