2024 KINDY ENROLMENTS

Enrolments are being received for our 3 year old and 4 year old Kindy programs for 2024. If you have not yet enrolled your child for next year, we encourage you to do so. The 3 year old Kindy program runs two days per week and you have the option to enrol your child for either half or full days. All children need to have turned three before starting this program. The 4 year old Kindy program runs three days a week (Mon, Wed & Fri) with the option to enrol for five days. All children need to turn four before June 30 of the school year for which they are enrolled. Once enrolled, your enrolment is carried over into the following year, so no further action is required. 
