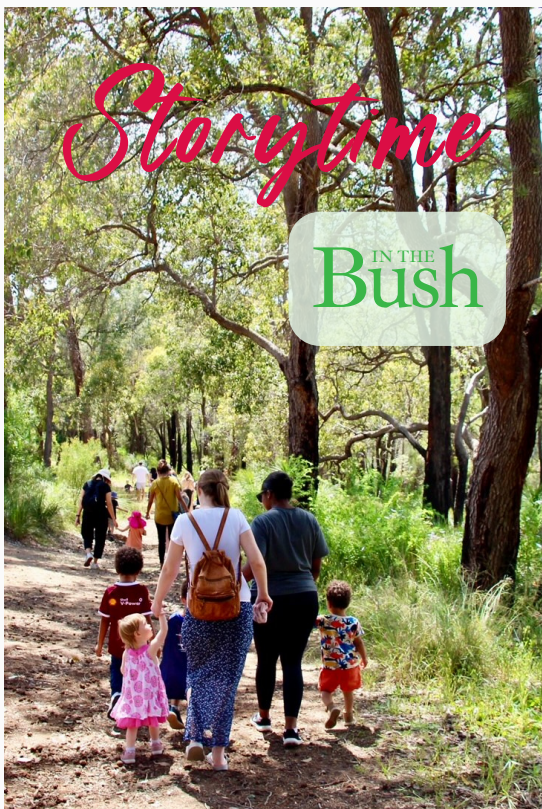

SCHOOL FEES
