Your school photo day is coming! Today every student will receive a personalised flyer to bring home from Kapture Photography containing your child's unique codes for ordering school photos online.

KEEP YOUR FLYER SECURE!

The unique codes contained on the flyer will be issued only once.

Order EARLY for sibling photography.

Sibling photos can ONLY be ordered online. Once you receive the personalised flyers for your children, it is imperative that you order your sibling photo early to avoid missing out! There is a physical limit in the school schedule to how many sibling photos can be taken. Once the maximum capacity of sibling orders has been reached, no more sibling orders can be placed. If maximum capacity is not reached, sibling orders close 12pm midday sharp, Tuesday May 2.

The school or the photographers cannot accept late orders for sibling photography. Please do not ask as your request simply cannot be accommodated.

Order EARLY for discount photo day prices.

Order your photos within 10 calendar days of photo day to receive discount photo day prices. Late orders are handled separately to the school delivery and incur a \$30 custom service charge.

Other information

Your school will notify you in a few weeks when team and special group photos are available to view and purchase on the Kapture website. Please note; class, individual and sibling portraits are not available to view online prior to purchase.

Kapture offer a money back guarantee for any parent who is not fully satisfied with their photo package. Should you have any queries before or after photo day, please check the FAQ's on the Kapture website.

All students will be photographed individually on photo day for school administration records AS WELL as included in their class group presentation available for purchase to all families. Should there be any reason why your child should NOT be included in the photo shoot - please contact the school office.

Uniform Requirements

Kindy & Pre Primary: Fleecy track pants & jumper with logo polo shirt.

Years 1-6 : Formal winter uniform, including v-neck jumpers and ties for boys

(NB- the navy jacket is not part of the formal uniform)

TERM 2 - WINTER UNIFORM

EARLY CHILDHOOD

- Kindy and Pre Primary students can wear the fleecy jacket and uniform micro-fibre pants or fleecy track pants for added warmth and wear & tear. The jacket and pants are supplied through the Carmel Primary Uniform Shop.

GIRLS (Years 1 - 6)

- Tartan skirt - touching the knee in standing position, white shirt embroidered with College Logo
- Polishable black lace-up shoes, or school shoe with black strap
- White ankle socks with one fold OR black/navy stockings or tights (please no low-cut sport socks and socks & tights are not to be worn together)
- Navy blue V-neck knit pullover with Carmel College logo

BOYS (Year 1 - 6)

- Mid-blue shirt with College logo and button up collar
- College grey trousers (no cargo pants)
- Polishable black lace-up school shoes with grey socks (please no low-cut sport socks). Boots/canvas shoes are not permitted
- School tie
- Navy blue V-neck knit pullover with Carmel College logo

Please note that the school jackets with school logo may be worn for additional warmth (this is optional only). Jackets do not replace the navy v-neck jumper with the Carmel Logo as part of the formal uniform. Formal uniforms may also be required for excursions, special events, public performances and other times as outlined in the newsletter from time to time.
