2022 Stationery List



Attached to this newsletter is the 2022 Stationery requirements.

Good news! As of the start of 2022, if you have children in Kindy - Year 2, you will no longer have to purchase stationery!

We have found that parents sometimes find it challenging to find some of the specialised items on the list. The teachers in Kindy - Year 2 have suggested that a cost be applied to fees rather than provide parents with a stationery list. Our aim is to bulk buy these items and save you the stress of trying to find them. This is a cost-neutral exercise, we do not aim to make any money on this venture but simply cover the cost.

What will this look like:

- 3YO Kindy - \$20 charge/ annually per student applied to tuition accounts.
- 4YO Kindy - \$30 charge/ annually per student applied to tuition accounts.
- PP-Year 2 - \$50 charge/ annually per student applied to tuition accounts.

For Years 3-6, the regular stationery list will remain. Many students love to be able to select and label their own stationery.

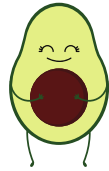

CONDITIONS FOR BUS TRAVEL

Passengers must obey these rules for bus travel

- PLEASE Follow the instructions of your Bus Driver.
- PLEASE Do not damage the bus interior or exterior, including seats.
- PLEASE Take care of the bus interior and exterior, including seats.
(Passengers will be financially responsible for any damage.)
- PLEASE Remain in your seat while the bus is moving.
- PLEASE Do not lean against the doors or out of the windows.
- PLEASE Respect the rights of your driver and other passengers.
This includes verbal and physical teasing and play fighting.
- PLEASE Stand away from the bus after getting off and please do not cross the road until it is clear.
- PLEASE Do not eat on the bus. This includes bubble gum and chewing gum, lollipops, lollies, chips, fruit, cooking class food or anything sticky.
- PLEASE Only drink water. No other drinks are allowed.
- PLEASE Do not throw anything out of the windows or around the inside of the bus at any time.
