If your child is late to school for any reason, please ensure they come to the front office to be signed in BEFORE they go to their classroom.

Bus Guidelines

We have had some reports from our bus drivers that not all students are abiding by the Buswest bus rules. To ensure safety at all times while travelling to and from school we ask that you please remind them of the following rules:

For your safety:

- Where seatbelts are fitted, they must be worn.
- To avoid injury should the bus need to brake suddenly, remain in your seat at all times.
- Leaning on doors or against windows is not safe.
 Please do not do this.
- Stand well away from bus after getting off and wait until the bus has moved away before crossing the road
- Be careful not to cross in front of the bus at any time, you may not be seen.
- Objects thrown from a moving vehicle cause serious damage. Please do not throw anything from the bus.
- Place bags under seat, between your feet or on your lap. Aisles must be kept clear, so please do not leave your bag in the aisle.

Behaviour Rules:

- Keep voices low always use an 'inside' voice.
- Inappropriate language, verbal teasing, play fighting or other physical contact is never acceptable.
- While the bus is waiting for secondary students, you must not leave the bus without the permission of the driver.
- There must be no calling out of bus windows/doors etc.


Just a courtesy reminder that Option B (termby-term) fees are due on or before the 30th July to receive the 2.5% discount.

Reading Progress


The most recent round of Star Reading results for secondary students are about to be released, and it's really exciting to see the progress that our students have made since the last round of testing.


