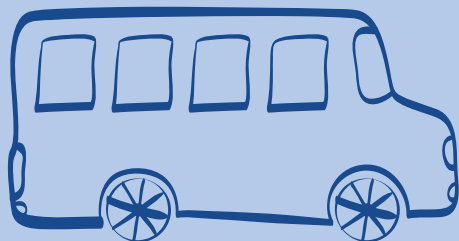

Year 6 Fun Day & Picnic Tea

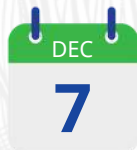


Our Year 6 students will enjoy a fun day out at Adventure World!

Concert, Awards Night & Year 6 Graduation



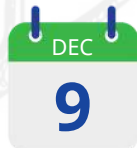
Save the date! This is our end of year Concert, Awards Night (for all grades) and Year 6 Graduation. This event is held at the Carmel College Secondary Gymnasium.

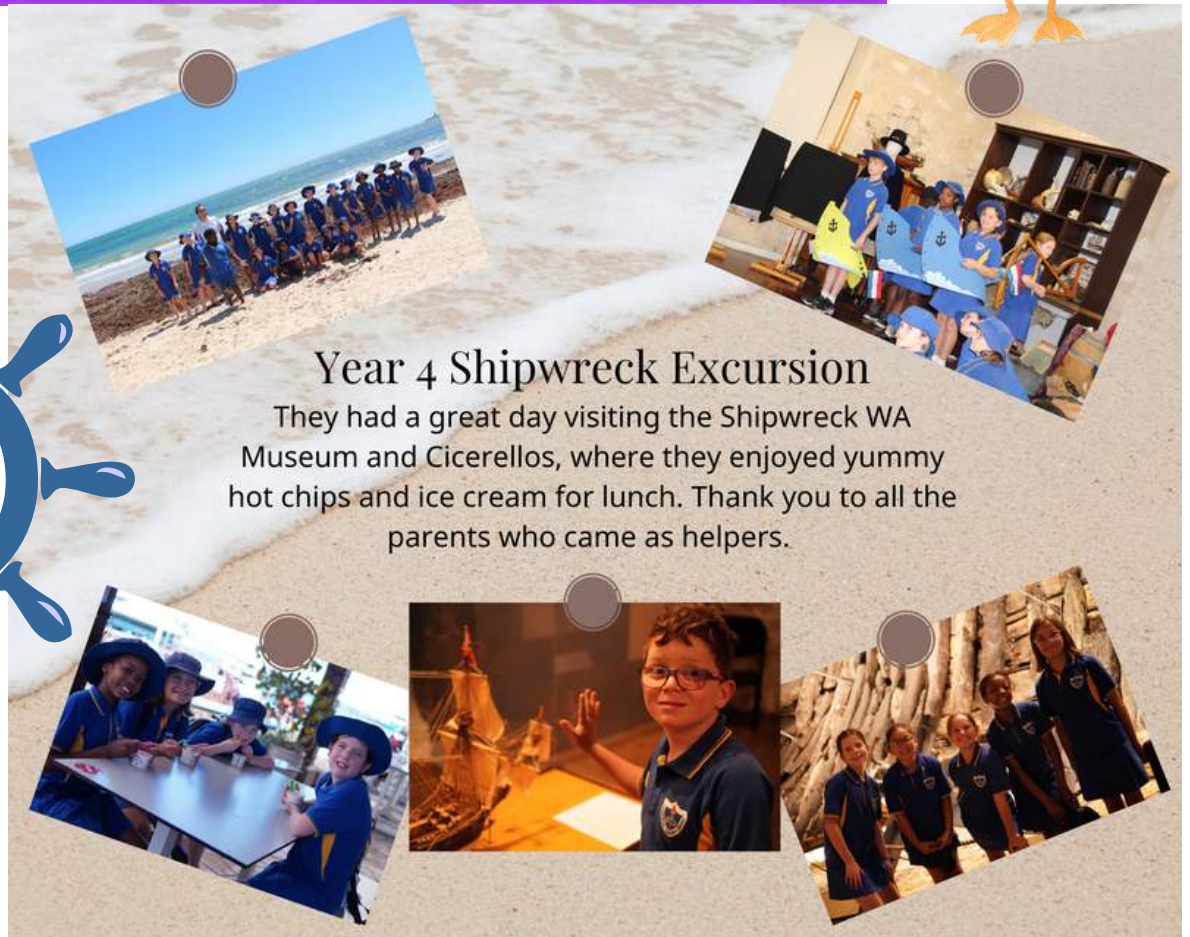

Year 3 – Perth City Excursion

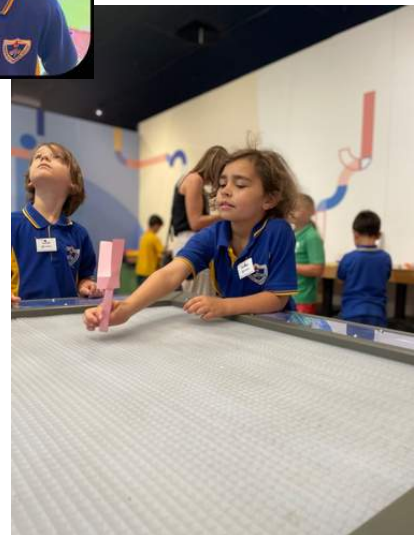
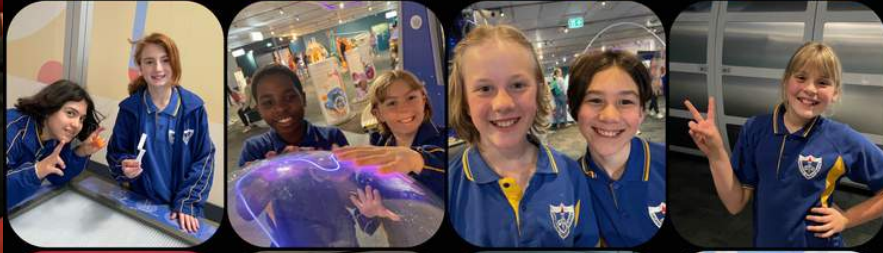
