

Kindy Enrolments

Enrolments are being received for our 3 year-old and 4 year-old Kindy program for 2023. If you have not yet enrolled your child for next year, we encourage you to do so.

The 3 year-old Kindy program runs 2 days a week. You have the option to enrol your child for either ½ days or full days. All children need to have turned three to start 3 year-old Kindy.

The 4 year-old Kindy program runs 3 days a week (Monday, Wednesday and Friday), with the option to enrol for 5 days. All children need to turn four before 30 June of the school year for which they are enrolled.

Once enrolled, your enrolment is carried over into the following year, so no further action is required.


To assist with the smooth running of the Sports Day, further information regarding buses, lunch, arrival & end of day procedures will be communicated to you closer to the event date.
