


School Banking

It's that time again! Mud Day is an opportunity for children to celebrate nature, outdoors, and mess, by getting really muddy. Students will have the opportunity to roll, squish, slide and splash in the mud.

Our mud pit and slide is located at the Secondary Campus near the dam. This year we will add a mud obstacle course!

Students will have the opportunity to enjoy the mud pit this Friday, August 11 at an allocated time (see below...start and finish times are approximate).

(**There will be NO LUNCH ORDERS for Students**)

On Friday, ALL students are to wear their **SPORT UNIFORM**. **Kindy, Pre-Primary and Year 1 students can come to school in their old clothes and change into their sport uniform afterwards.

THIS ACTIVITY IS ENTIRELY OPTIONAL. NO STUDENT WILL BE FORCED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE MUD PIT.

If your child/ren would like to participate in the MUD PIT, here is some important information:

- Pack an old towel, old clothes, thongs, change of underwear and tough plastic bag. Students will need to be washed down after the mud pit.
- MUST WEAR swimming goggles (mud/clay can sting if you get it in your eyes) and HIGHLY RECOMMEND
 a swimming/shower cap/beanie if you have long hair. It can take a lot of time to wash the mud out of
 students with long hair.
- Bring along the oldest, most ragged clothes that you have almost outgrown to change into for the mud pit. You may not want to take these home again as they will be thick with mud!
 If you do want the clothes brought home after the event, ensure you have a tough plastic bag. If you
 - If you do want the clothes brought home after the event, ensure you have a <u>tough</u> plastic bag. If you would prefer the clothes do not come home, send a note and we will dispose of them in our big bin.
- Students will be able to have a shower at the Carmel Secondary Gymnasium.
- Students need to change into their sports uniform again, after the mud pit.
- If your child has been sick or you simply would prefer they did not play in the mud, just ensure the class teacher knows.
