# **The Triple Filter Test**

"Hold on a minute," Socrates replied. "Before telling me anything I'd like you to pass a little test. It's called the Triple Filter Test." "Triple filter?"

"So," Socrates continued, "you want to tell me something bad about him, but you're not certain it's true. You may still pass the test though, because there's one filter left: the filter of usefulness. Is what you want to tell me about my friend going to be useful to me?"

"No not really ..."

"Well," concluded Socrates, "if what you want to tell me is neither true nor good nor even useful, why tell it to me at all?" This is why Socrates was a great philosopher & held in such high esteem. May we all use such filters!

# **Combined Schools Sports Day**

## **ARRIVING...**

For parents transporting their children directly to the field, please note the following: **Students need to be at the track by 9am.** 

Please report to Mrs Blagden upon arrival to collect your card. Mrs Blagden will show you which area to put your bag in and also where to line up for the opening announcements.

Students need to be supervised by their parents prior to the commencement of the program. Carmel will only have two or three staff members at the grounds and they will be busy setting up for the various events. The rest of the staff will be travelling to the field on the buses with the students. Please note that children are NOT allowed to play on the tracks or with sporting equipment before the official event starts.

# END OF THE DAY PROCEDURES...

All Carmel students are required to stay in the assigned Carmel area until checked off the attendance list. Teachers signing off students will be wearing their 'High-Vis' vests. All students belonging to one family need to be signed off together. Please be grouped together before coming to be checked off.

Class Room	Items to donate for Boys and Girls
Kindy and Pre Primary	Something to love – soft toy, doll or teddy
Year 1	Something for school – note pad, pencils, pencil case, chalk, coloured pencils, any stationary items
Year 2	Something for school – note pad, pencils, pencil case, chalk, coloured pencils, any stationary items
Year 3	Something to play with – marbles, tennis ball, skipping rope, yo- yo, slinky
Year 4	Something special – stickers, craft kit, bangles, sun glasses, material carry bag
Year 5	Something for hygiene – toothbrush, hair clips, comb, brush, soap (no liquids)
Year 6	Something to wear – thongs, underwear, cap, t shirt or sandals

Please note all items must be new and NOT used and NO battery items or liquids can be sent. Most importantly the items must be able to fit inside a shoebox.

If you're unable to donate any of the above items a small monetary donation would be greatly appreciated. Each shoe box costs \$10 in delivery fees to ensure even children in remote areas receive a shoebox.

The more items we receive, the more shoeboxes we can fill and hopefully assist with changing children's lives. The closing date for the items is Friday 6<sup>th</sup> November 2020.
