Charles Plumb, a U.S. Naval Academy graduate, was a jet pilot in Vietnam. After 75 combat missions, his plane was destroyed by a surfaceto-air missile. Plumb ejected and parachuted into enemy hands. He was captured and spent 6 years in a communist Vietnamese prison. He survived the ordeal and now lectures on lessons learned from that experience.

One day, when Plumb and his wife were sitting in a restaurant, a man at another table came up and said, "You're Plumb! You flew jet fighters in Vietnam from the aircraft carrier Kitty Hawk. You were shot down!" "How in the world did you know that?" asked Plumb. "I packed your parachute," the man replied. Plumb gasped in

I wonder how many times I might have seen him and not even said 'Good morning,' 'how are you?' or anything because, you see, I was a fighter pilot and he was just a sailor."

Plumb also points out that he needed many kinds of parachutes when his plane was shot down over enemy territory he needed his physical parachute, his mental parachute, his emotional parachute, and his spiritual parachute. He called on all these supports before reaching safety.

Sometimes in the daily challenges that life gives us, we miss what is really important. We may fail to say hello, please, or thank you, congratulate someone on something wonderful that has happened to them, give a compliment, or just do something nice for no reason. As you go through this week, this month, this year, recognise people who pack your parachute.

## **Revision to Uniform Policy**

#### **Sport Shoes**

We have previously asked for predominantly white, black, blue or red. No logos and brand features such as Barbie, etc.

We are now ADDING one more colour predominantly grey. This seems to be a new colour available and it looks guite smart with the school uniform.

We hope that by giving a few more options, that you will find it easier to meet the uniform policy guidelines.

#### Sport Socks

Please note that we have modified our Sport Sock requirement slightly. This change is applicable as of now.

Plain white socks/ no logo remains the standard. However, we have modified the length to be simply that the sock needs to be visible above the shoe line. Those who have socks that are above the ankle are still good, but this also allows the slightly lower cut socks. See below for examples.

- Sock visible above shoe line are okay.

- Sock not visible above shoe line are not acceptable. - If there is a logo on the bottom of the sock, this is not an issue. The portion seen, needs to be plain white.



## Hats – IMPORTANT INFORMATION

School hats are to be worn during recess, lunch, sport and any other outside activities.



Please note: Without a hat, play will be is restricted to the verandahs.
