ABSENT/LATE STUDENTS

At Carmel we take your child's duty of care seriously and, as such, we need to be informed whenever a child is absent from school. This can be done in by phoning between 8.30-9.00am or email admin@carmelcollegeprimary.wa.edu.au on the morning of your child's absence.

If your child is late to school for any reason, you MUST sign the late register book in the office BEFORE they can go to class.

VISITORS

Any one who comes to the school (other than to pick up or drop off their child/ren) MUST sign the 'Visitor' book in the office and wear a green 'visitor' sticker with their name on it. This is to clearly mark who is a registered person within our school grounds and thereby identifying any person who shouldn't be here. While this may seem to be a bit of a pain, we do it in the interest of keeping your children safe from undesirables.

SWIMMING LESSONS – Next Monday (Feb 9)

Swimming Lessons commence NEXT week and will run for 2 weeks. During this time ALL students (except Kindy) are required to wear their Sport uniform to school every day. They need to bring their swim wear in a waterproof bag to school in the morning. PLEASE ENSURE THAT ALL ITEMS **OF CLOTHING ARE CLEARLY LABELLED.**

If your child has participated in swimming lessons over the year-end break and has passed a level, please send a copy of their certificate to the school. The Swimming Instructors require this certificate to validate the level of swimming your child has enrolled in.

If you would like to arrange to personally collect your child from the swimming pool after the lessons, please speak directly to your child's teacher BEFORE-HAND and confirm in writing. Any child not collected by a parent by the time the bus leaves, will be put on the bus and returned to the school. NO child will be left at the pool unattended.

Swimming lessons are held at Gosnells Leisure World, Culross Avenue, Thornlie. Spectators will be charged an entry fee at the pool.

PARKING – making First Avenue a safe place in the before and after school rush.

Please be aware that the area in front of the main entry to the school is the bus drop-off point for buses each morning. There is also a longer section required for buses here each afternoon as well.

If you are dropping-off or collecting your child by car, please park by the second entry-way in front of the library or in the carpark across the road. Thanks for your help in making our school a safe place.

SCHOOL FEES

Over the last couple of years we have had a growing number of parents wanting to know the full amount of their school fees for the year so they can budget accordingly. In order to assist families in this area the school has decided to charge fees annually rather then each term. Please do not panic this does not mean you will be required to pay all your fees immediately. You can still continue paying each term if that's what option suits you best. In order to make managing your fees easier the school is offering 4 different payment options. They will be as follows:

Option A : 1 annual payment with 5% discount on tuition fees (Due 20th February)

Option B : 4 quarterly payments with a 2.5% discount on tuition fees (Term 1 due 20th February)

Option C : 10 monthly instalments due on the 15th of the month (from February to November)

Option D : 20 fortnightly instalments due on the 14th & 28th of each month (from February to November)

Along with your fee statement you will be sent 2 other forms. It's important to note that the blue form tilted, Payment Commitment Form, will need to be returned to the office by next Friday, 13th February. Narelle is hoping to have your fee information posted out to you this week.

CENTRELINK PAYMENT OPTIONS

Centrepay - the easy way to pay your bills and expenses. Centrepay is a voluntary bill-paying service which is free for Centrelink customers. Use Centrepay to arrange regular deductions from your Centrelink payment. You can start or change a deduction at any time. The quickest way to do it is through your Centrelink account online.

SPORT HOUSES
