
Semester 1 reports will be available for PARENTS to collect from the office on **Tuesday**, **26**th **June**.

Joseph and Ann Hardey arrived in Perth in 1830. They were also known for helping the sick and those in need. With no church building, they would hold church services in their home with Joseph being the preacher. They waited until June 1840, for the Swan River Colony to have their first minister.
