NAPLAN RESULTS 2017

Congratulations to our Year 7 and Year 9 students for their efforts in the 2017 NAPLAN. Parents of students involved should have received their results in the mail. If you haven't please contact the school.

Teachers use the NAPLAN results to help design and prepare programs to improve students' literacy and numeracy skills.

Students and teachers are to be commended for the growth that is happening from Year 7 to Year 9.

Some of the highlights include:

- Year 7 students' Spelling, Grammar and Punctuation averages were higher than State and National averages and their Numeracy average was higher than Similar schools.
- Year 9 students' averages were higher than State, National and Similar school averages in ALL components of NAPLAN (Numeracy, Reading, Writing, Spelling and Grammar & Punctuation).

IPAD LEASE REFUND

We would like to apologise that the iPad programme has not been available this year. As such the iPad Lease charge for 2017 has been reversed for all Year 7- Year 10 students. This will impact fee accounts for a number of families and the following action should be taken based on the Option you have selected.

Option A: If you have not already done so, please advise re fees in credit. It would be appreciated if you could reference your family code in any correspondence for accounting purposes.

Option B: Please adjust your final payment amount by the amount reversed (\$289.66 for one child, \$579.32 for two children), not forgetting your entitlement to prompt payment discount if paid by 20/10/2017.

Option C and D: Please adjust your final payment amount by the amount reversed (\$289.66 for one child, \$579.32 for two children). This may mean that fees are finalised prior to 28/11/2017, or that the final payment is significantly less than originally anticipated.

Families with automatic payments arranged through the school will have the necessary adjustments made to their final payment amount.


