

### **School Fees**

Fee statements were posted to all families last week. Please check your statements thoroughly and contact myself should you find any discrepancies.

Just a reminder regarding payment dates:

**Option B (Term-by-Term)** - To receive your 2.5% discount, please ensure Term 3's fee payment is paid on or before Friday, 27th July (week 2).

**Option C (Monthly) -** payments are due on the  $15^{\text{th}}$  of each month.

**Option D (Fortnightly) -** payments are due on the 14<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> of each month.

We totally understand that the monthly and fortnightly due dates may not suit all pay cycles. Please note if you have chosen to make monthly/fortnightly payments you are required to make at least 1 payment per month or 2 fortnightly payments per month. This will then ensure your fees are finalised by the end of November.

Please remember to keep us up to date and contact us if you are experiencing financial difficulties or have had a change in circumstances. We are more than happy to make accommodations and alternative payment arrangements, but can only do so if we are aware of your situation.


