Dear Year 9 Parents and Guardians,

On the 4th of August, we are excitedly anticipating a visit to Curtin University for a captivating Science Day. This event will immerse students in a dynamic STEM experience day at the university campus. Throughout the day, participants will have the chance to explore the campus, interact with STEM ambassadors, and participate in engaging hands-on science workshops.

The hands-on workshops have been thoughtfully crafted to empower school students by providing them with the opportunity to apply their skills in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics through interactive explorations. These sessions will be facilitated by passionate Curtin student ambassadors, who will not only guide the students through the activities but also share their own educational journeys and career aspirations in the field of STEM.

To ensure student safety throughout the excursions, students must complete another travel plan and ensure they stay with the class at Curtin for the duration of the excursion.

There is opportunity to buy lunch, so students can either bring a snack and lunch or purchase it there. Teacher supervision will commence at 9:30am and conclude at 2:00pm. Students will be dismissed at 2pm from Curtin University.

Aims of Urban Excursion:

Social/Emotional & Academic - opportunity to build leadership and communication skills within the STEM area. Students will build upon foundational knowledge learned during Science class and apply it with hands on experience. This will also help students to build positive memories and stronger relationships with each other, and to continue to develop resilience and confidence.
