

YEAR 9 ASPIRE PROGRAMME – Urban Day 5: Army Museum of WA and Fremantle Prison. Date: Friday, 25th July 2025

Dear Year 9 Parents and Guardians,

On the 25th of July, we will be visiting the Army Museum of WA and the Fremantle Prison.

To ensure student safety throughout the excursions, students must complete another travel plan and ensure they stay with the class for the duration of the excursion.

Teacher supervision will commence at 9:45am and conclude at 2:30pm. Students will be dismissed at 2.30pm from Fremantle Prison.

Aims of Urban Excursion:

Social/Emotional & Academic - Students will learn about World War I (and other conflicts) at the Army Museum which will be a reference point for the present Year 9 Humanities and Social Sciences content related to History. Students will also visit the Roundhouse, a significant historical site in Fremantle.

Starting Location & Time : Army Museum of WA, 6 Burt St, Fremantle, 9:45am. Ending Location & Time: Fremantle Prison, 1 The Terrace, Fremantle, 2:30pm.

Transport Information:

Students will need to catch public transport from home and meet their class at 9:45am at the Army Museum.

Transport Form:

Students will need to get themselves to the **Army Museum of WA by 9:45am.** There will be a teacher present from 9:30am for any students that arrive early. **Teacher supervision will end at 2:30pm** once we are finished at **Fremantle Prison** where students will then follow their travel plans to get home.

Checklist of what to bring on Thursday:

- □ Wear a **FULL WINTER** uniform. (No other clothing items permitted)
- □ PE Bag (or official school bag only)
- □ SmartRider (for public transport concession fare) or cash for bus/train ticket
- □ Lunch, snacks and water bottle
- □ Pen, pencil
- □ Money (optional)- to buy a lunch/snack at the end of the excursion

Permission Forms and Signed Agreement :

Because of the special nature of these excursions, each student and parent must **submit a signed agreement and travel plan** (see pages below) **by Wednesday, the 23rd of July**.

Please note that teacher supervision commences 9:30am at the Army Museum. The excursion runs from 10:00am and concludes at 2:30pm at Fremantle Prison.

Students may arrive early or stay later in Fremantle if arranged with parents, but there will be no teacher supervision during this time.
