

YEAR 10 RAC BSTREETSMART Date: Tuesday, 25th March

Dear Parents, Carers & Students,

As part of the Key for Life - Pre-driver Education programme that the Year 10 cohort are currently undertaking, students will be attending the RAC bstreetsmart event being held at RAC Arena on **Tuesday 25th March.**

Students are required to wear their full formal uniform to attend this event and may be sent home if they do not comply with this rule.

The RAC bstreetsmart event is split into two parts. The first part is a live re-enactment of a car crash illustrating how the emergency services work together in this situation. There will be police cars, ambulances and fire engines on the floor of the arena with lights and sirens sounding during parts of the re-enactment. The second part is hearing from multiple presenters who have been affected by road trauma is some way. They share their story and advice for young drivers.

Using the skills students learned in the Year 9 Aspire Programme during the Urban Learning Days, we are requesting that all students meet at The Green Cactus (outside Perth Train Station in Forest Place). Students should aim to arrive between 9:20 – 9:30am.

At the conclusion of the event, students will be free to leave and make their own way home or stay in the city with parent permission. Staff supervision will end at 2:30pm.
