

YEAR 9 ASPIRE PROGRAMME – Urban Day 2: Parliament House and English & Maths Challenge in Perth.

Dates: Wednesday, 24 May 2023

Dear Year 9 Parents and Guardians,

On the 24 of May 2023 we are completing an English and Maths Challenge and visiting Parliament House as part of the Civics and Citizenship unit for HASS. For the English and Maths component, students will work together in small groups and complete a task.

Students must wear **FULL Formal Uniform** (no mixing of formal uniform with PE uniform) and if students are not dressed appropriately, they may be sent home.

Due to bag restrictions at Parliament House, if students wish to bring a bag, they may use their PE bag. No large bags (i.e. normal school bag) are permitted.

To ensure student safety throughout the excursions, students **MUST stay together** in their groups **and check in with teachers at the agreed times.** Although part of this excursion will be 'out of sight' of teachers, the teachers will be near students throughout the activities and will be able to reach students within minutes. If your child does not have a phone, that is okay, they will be placed in a group that has a phone.

Aims of Urban Excursion:

Academic - to consolidate classroom learning, experience hands on learning in the real world and further develop teamwork skills.

Social/Emotional - opportunity to build positive memories and stronger relationships with each other, and to continue to develop resilience and confidence.

Physical - opportunity to enjoy learning outdoors together.

Costs: Students will need to bring their own recess (there will not be an opportunity to purchase recess food), their own lunch or bring money to purchase lunch. Students will need to bring their Smart Rider or \$4.40 if they don't have a SmartRider.

Transport Information:

As students got the experience of catching public transport as a large group with staff on our last Urban Excursion, students have been instructed to create a travel plan that will get themselves to Forrest Place (The Green Cactus) by 9:30am and back home again from Water Town leaving at 2:30pm. These travel plans need to be signed by a parent/guardian and returned with the permission form by **Friday 19th May.**

Checklist of what to bring on Wednesday (24 May):

- SmartRider (for public transport concession fare) or \$4.40 if it has not been ordered. (There is no student discount without a Smart Rider)
- Lunch and Snacks. Alternatively, students can purchase their lunch
- Fully charged phone (if you have one)
- Pen
- Camera (optional)
- PE bag to carry any items if needed (must bring a school issued bag if you bring one). Please note the large school bag will not be permitted at Parliament House.

Permission Forms and Signed Agreement:

Because of the special nature of these excursions, each student and parent must **submit a signed travel agreement** (see last page for a template) **by Friday morning, the 19**th **of May**. Students may miss out on the excursion if they do not submit on time. Students have been given time at school to complete their travel plans via the Transperth website.

Please note that teacher supervision commences 9:15am at the Green Cactus in Forrest Place. The excursion runs from 9:30am and concludes at 2:30pm at Watertown.

Students may arrive early or stay later in the city if arranged with parents, but there will be no teacher supervision during this time.
